



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VISION



INFRA STRUCTURE

Proximity to Sanpada Railway Station

Situated in the heart of the city, OCE is the natural choice and preferred destination for students to pursue professional education. The distance to the college from the Sanpada railway station is less than a kilometre, making the commute easy and time saving for our students.

Sanitation and Rest




CLASSROOMS


AUDITORIUM

celebrated the day, students participated in the different activities like tongue twister, Riddle etc.


15th August 2021: Independence Day

5. Laughter



WALKING IN AS A STUDENT, WALKING OUT AS A TEACHER "





COMMUNITY WORK

- In February of 2022, our SY.BEd students hand made some paper bags and distributed it to the local vendors. with an aim of fostering and promoting an eco friendly mindset by creating and distributing better alternatives to plastic bags.
- On 21st March 2022. OCE collaborated with the **Rotary Club of** Millenium City, Navi Mumbai to celebrate and spread awareness on the occasion of World Forestry Day. The Secretary of the Club, educated our students on the importance of mangroves and the dire need to conserve them.
- On this day, our students also contributed handmade paper bags to the *Red* **Dot initiative**. The Red Dot initiative targets the safe disposal of dirty pads and diapers; it sensitizes participants to the problems faced by waste-pickers who perforce need to handle this as part of their everyday work.

The Semester 4 internship started in March 2022. It was a 4 week internship that took place entirely offline, and concluded in April 2022.
