> Resume Making Workshop:





Campus Placement Drive (3rd March 2022 onwards)





The Placement Cell of OCE hosted various placement drives for S.Y. B.Ed. students from 3rd March to 7th March at the college campus. The event began at 11 AM with the Principal's speech, emphasizing the importance of such initiatives in bridging the gap between academia and employment. The selection process included online interviews, microteaching sessions, and personal interviews, with around 40 students participating. These activities assessed candidates' pedagogical knowledge, teaching styles, and classroom management abilities. By the end of the drive, 15 students received job offers, and another 10 were shortlisted for further rounds. The recruitment teams praised the college for the well-organized event and were impressed with the quality of candidates.










> Resume Making Workshop - 14th January 2022



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On January 14th, 2022, Asst.Professor Asmita Wewhare conducted a highly informative "Online Resume and CV Making Workshop" designed to support students in their placement endeavors. The virtual session was structured to cover essential aspects of resume and CV creation, including the differentiation between the two, key components such as contact information, career objectives, educational background, work experiences, and relevant skills.

Ms. Asmita Mam provided detailed guidance on writing effective content, emphasizing the use of action verbs and quantifiable achievements to enhance document impact. The workshop also focused on best practices in formatting, layout design, and customization tailored to specific job roles. Participants actively engaged in interactive exercises and received personalized feedback, enhancing their ability to create professional resumes and CVs tailored to prospective employers' expectations. Feedback from attendees was positive, highlighting the workshop's practical value in improving students' readiness for successful job placements in an online and offline format. Participants reported feeling more confident in their ability to create tailored and professional documents that effectively showcase their qualifications and experiences.

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➤ Soft Skills Training - 6th August 2021






On August 6, 2021, at 2 PM, the Students Council and Placement Cell of Oriental College, Sanpada, hosted an online lecture titled "Talk Right by Regulating Emotions" for the F.Y. B.Ed. class. The session focused on soft skills, which include a blend of people skills, social skills, communication abilities, personality traits, attitudes, career attributes, social intelligence, and emotional intelligence. Recognizing the importance of these skills for future teachers, the Student Council arranged the lecture, delivered by their classmate Ms. Shweta Pandey, who is pursuing Image Consulting and Soft Skills at Image Consulting Business Institute (ICBI). Ms. Pandey discussed different communication styles, the 7 C's, and the 3 V's of communication, using examples and short advertisement clips to illustrate her points. She emphasized the importance of connecting the brain with the heart and delved into the components and significance of emotional intelligence. The session concluded with a reflective question for the students: "How do you want others to see you?" This informative and much-needed session was greatly appreciated by all the students for its role in grooming them as future educators.

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> Educational Technology and Online Teaching Skills:



The workshop on Educational Technology and Online Teaching Skills by making use of Online educational tools, held on 11 October 2021, provided an invaluable learning experience for educators seeking to enhance their digital teaching competencies. > Placement Drive Report: OCE Placement Drive - 27th November 2019

The Placement Cell of OCE organized multiple placement drives for second-year B.Ed. students. The selection process comprised a written examination, micro-teaching sessions, and individual interviews, attracting approximately 24 enthusiastic students seeking teaching positions. 
➤ Guest Lecture on Teacher's Olympiad and Placement - 22.11.2018
