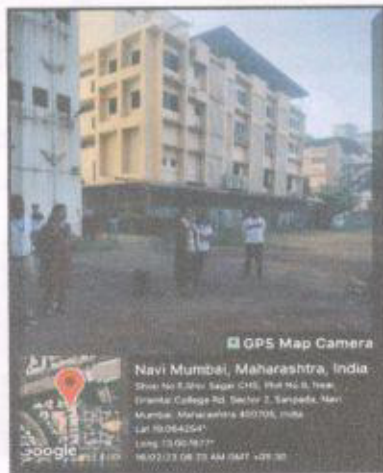
If there is one field of life which teaches us the most valuable lessons about perseverance, patience, in fact what constitutes a perfect character, it is sports.

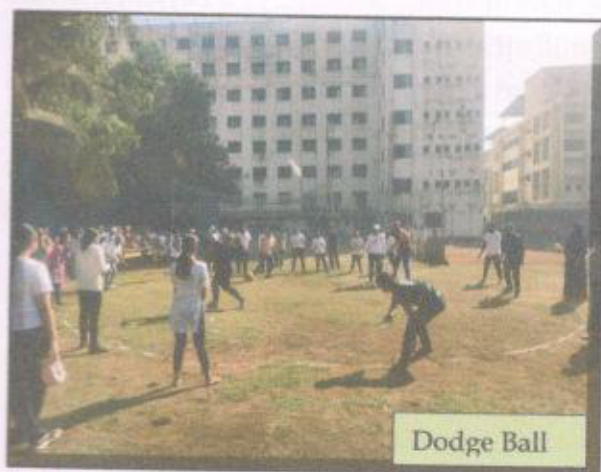

INTER- COLLEGE SPORTS MEET 2018-19




