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3. To achieve a safe, secure, and environmentally conscious campus community and thoroughly reduce energy consumption, ensuring appropriate indoor air quality, and improving energy efficiency on campus.
4. To protect and conserve ecological systems and resources within and outside the campus.
5. To educate student teachers to create awareness.
6. To make student teachers understand the importance of environment and its problem areas.

Energy Conservation Implementation:

Oriental College of Education is committed to maximize energy conservation procedures through various measures.

1. Oriental College of Education has created an institution-wide energy conservation plan and implemented a mechanism to use renewable energy.
2. Change in behaviour and habits to consume less energy in our daily activities
3. LED bulbs are used in the campus for internal lighting. (Replacement of the existing conventional lighting with the LED lamps.)
4. Energy conservation methods and environmentally friendly behaviours are instilled in students and staff by warning them about basic measures that can significantly cut electricity consumption, such as having them switch off all lights, appliances, and electronics when not in use.
5. Awareness on Energy conservation: Energy conservation education is a top priority for a college and, more importantly, for our students. Sustainability initiatives, energy savings indicators are all high priorities. Encourage students to celebrate World Environment day Swachhata Pakhwada.. Raising awareness of these initiatives can have significant benefits, such as motivating desired behaviour on how a campus building can and should be used to support a college on reduction goals.
6. Encourage students and staff to be energy efficient by encouraging use of E-vehicle and use of bicycles.
7. Organising expert lectures in the area of energy conservation.
8. Maintain the Energy needs of the campus with back-up power supply system for supplying uninterrupted energy demands.
9. The Institute shall continuously review and update the approved policy and is committed to its implementation.
10. Directions are given to students for the proper utilization of the electronic devices in the institution. Ensures all the institutional electronics are turned off when not in use.


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11. Reduce e-waste to maximum with proper maintenance, before moving on to Replace & Recycle stage.
12. Use of energy efficient, star labelled equipments for various purposes.
13. Students and faculty members are given adequate training for energy audit procedures for sustainable institutional and household energy conservation.
14. Effective usage of Day light and natural ventilation.
15. Mandatory practice of switching off lights when not in use.
16. No use of air condition during the winters.
17. Promotes No plastic policy
18. Collaborated with agencies and authorized vendors for recycle of E waste collection
19. Go for less use of paper .
20. Segregation of Dry waste and wet Waste .
