Mentoring activities are integrated throughout the coursework. Depending on the needs of student-teachers, mentors engage in activities such as:

- Providing guidance on developing lesson plans
- Conducting demonstration lessons
- Offering basic ICT training as required
- Assisting with writing effective answers
- Recommending reference books for subjects requiring additional support
- Providing support for personal issues as necessary

# Structure of Mentoring Activities for First Year B.Ed.

- To orient student-teachers about the B.Ed. course structure
- To acquaint student-teachers about basics of ICT
- To help student-teachers in internship activities
- To help the mentees in any other issue, as requested.

In the F.Y.B.Ed. Program, mentoring sessions focus on regular interactions between mentors and mentees. Mentors concentrate on understanding the challenges that student-teachers encounter during the course, particularly due to their diverse academic backgrounds. To support them, regular guidance sessions are organized to familiarize mentees with the course structure, assignments, answer writing, and exam preparation.

Given the essential role of ICT in the teaching-learning process, students who face difficulties in this area receive guidance on basic computer skills, including practical training in MS-Office and other essentials. Additional time is allocated in the computer lab for these students to practice and build proficiency.

During the first year, students embark on their internship for the first time. In addition to the standard orientation and micro-teaching sessions, mentors ensure mentees acquire skills in effective lesson planning.

# Report of Peer Feedback/Tutoring

Peer Feedback is given during internship, in a structured format in the lessons delivered in schools. Student-teachers observe their peers' lessons at internship schools and provide constructive feedback using a prescribed format. According to the syllabus, each student is required to observe five lessons taught by their peers. This feedback process helps students identify areas for improvement in their own teaching and refine their lesson delivery skills.

Peer feedback is integral to both academic and co-curricular activities organized by students. During lessons, cooperative learning strategies are employed, offering students opportunities to provide feedback to their peers. Workshops and seminars related to the B.Ed. coursework also incorporate constructive peer feedback. Tutoring sessions during remedial and revision classes involve student-teachers in group activities where they explain assigned topics to their peers.

Co-curricular events such as festivals, important days, and daily assemblies are held regularly throughout the year. Peers provide constructive feedback, formally and informally, during meetings with teachers in charge, which aids in enhancing the planning and execution of these activities.

# Report of Remedial Learning Engagement

The college timetable allocated specific lectures for providing remedial support for various theory courses, conducted before examinations. Content Enrichment programs were implemented to enhance comprehension of diverse concepts. Student-teachers were equipped with learning materials and resources, including references to online educational content and links to various educational websites through regularly updated library blogs.

#### **Content Enrichment Programs**

#### A.Y. 2018-19

On November 10, 2018, Dr. Sangeeta Nath conducted the Content Enrichment program. The objective of the program was to enhance the quality, depth, and relevance of educational content, thereby improving the overall learning experience for students.

Mam emphasized the importance of writing proper lesson plans according to the objectives and the importance of use of effective teaching aids to make learning meaningful. The role of critical thinking in enabling students to solve problems effectively and how they can apply their knowledge in real-life situations was discussed.

#### A.Y. 2019-20

#### A.Y. 2020-21

Oriental College of Education conducted a session titled "Creating Online Lesson Plans and Addressing Challenges in Online Practice Teaching" on September 19, 2020, conducted in an online format due to the shift from face-to-face to online learning caused by Covid-19. Many student-teachers faced challenges adapting to this sudden transition to ICT-based teaching.

Mrs. Falguni Shah served as the resource person, addressing the challenges encountered during online practice teaching. She highlighted common issues such as network connectivity problems and the lack of suitable devices for lesson preparation among students.

Mrs. Shah also provided guidance on how to effectively create online lesson plans, which proved beneficial for student-teachers preparing for their practice teaching sessions. She discussed various components of lesson plans such as assessing Previous Knowledge, engaging Set Induction, developing lesson content, initiating class activities, and utilizing online platforms like Blackboard for interactive learning experiences.

All participants attentively followed the instructions and took notes during the session, which was highly informative and enriching.

#### A.Y. 2021-22

Oriental College of Education conducted an LMS Online Assessment Tools session for B.Ed. student-teachers on 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2021. The program highlighted the implementation of platforms like Moodle and Canvas to create dynamic and interactive assessments.

On January 19, 2023, a training program focused on creating and leveraging Google Classroom was organized to enhance digital teaching skills among student-teachers. The session commenced with an overview of Google Classroom's interface, highlighting its seamless integration with other Google Workspace tools. Participants were guided through the process of setting up new classrooms, inviting students, and organizing course materials into topics and modules.

The training emphasized the simplicity of creating and distributing assignments, announcements, and resources, demonstrating how Google Classroom can streamline classroom management and promote a well-structured learning environment.

Later in the session, the training shifted focus to the interactive features of Google Classroom, such as facilitating class discussions via the Stream, providing timely feedback on student submissions, and utilizing the Gradebook for progress tracking.
