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## 1. No special effort put forth in accordance with learner needs.

National Seminar on Digital Pedagogy-Challenges and Perspectives: On 27th October 2018, OCE, Department of Education, organized a one-day National Seminar on Digital pedagogy its challenges and perspectives. The event organizing secretaries were Dr. Sangeeta Nath and Dr. Harjot Kaur Dhatt. Keynote speaker for the event was, Dr. Sameer S Sahasrabudhe, introduced us to the world of digital pedagogy and its applicability in modern learning. The vote of thanks was delivered by Professor Sangeeta Nath followed by the certificate distribution.

**One-day workshop on Craft and skill**: Oriental College Of Education, Sanpada, invited Mrs. Vidya Angholakar from Rotary Club conducted a one-day workshop on craft and skills. This workshop was actually a vocational training for students to make cloth bags and diya decoration used in Diwali. The motive behind this workshop to enhance the creativity inside the students. Mrs. Vidya Angholakar instructed students on how to make cloth bags and decorate diyas. Students actively participated in this event, made beautiful cloth bags and diyas.

### 2. Only when Students seek support

**Remedial Learning Engagement:** The college timetable allocated specific lectures for providing remedial support for various theory courses, conducted before examinations.

The remedial program provides targeted assistance in subjects where students may need additional help, offering personalized tutoring and supplemental resources. Through a combination of one-on-one sessions and interactive learning tools, students receive focused instruction tailored to their specific needs. By fostering a collaborative learning environment and addressing individual academic gaps, the initiative aims to enhance student performance and boost overall confidence and success.

**Personal counselling** - Personal Counseling Session Organized for Student Betterment. The college conducted a personal counselling session to support students' overall well-being and academic success. This session provided a confidential space for students to discuss personal challenges, academic concerns, and career aspirations with trained counsellors. The counsellors offered individualized advice, helping students navigate stress, improve time management, and set realistic goals. Through one-on-one interactions, students received tailored strategies to enhance their personal and academic development. The session emphasized the importance of mental health, self-awareness, and goal-setting. Overall, this initiative aimed to foster a supportive environment and equip students with the skills to achieve both personal and academic success.

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### 3. As an institutionalized activity in accordance with learner needs

**Mentoring Program:** Mentors are assigned to student-teachers upon completion of the admission process to facilitate their understanding of the coursework. Throughout the program, mentors assist and advise students on various academic tasks, internships, and projects.

The mentoring program aims to achieve the following objectives:

- 1. Foster a supportive learning environment by building a strong bond between mentors and mentees.
- 2. Guide student-teachers in successfully completing their theory courses, internships, and assigned projects.
- 3. Address personal issues of mentees and offer guidance when needed.

Mentoring activities are integrated throughout the coursework. Depending on the needs of student-teachers, mentors engage in activities such as:

- Providing guidance on developing lesson plans
- Conducting demonstration lessons
- Offering basic ICT training as required
- Assisting with writing effective answers
- Recommending reference books for subjects requiring additional support
- Providing support for personal issues as necessary

**Workshops for Internship Activities:** For internship activities, Student-teachers are oriented for various teaching skills. Micro-teaching skills, demo lessons on cooperative teaching-learning, orientation of theme lessons, orientation of co-teaching lessons, and workshops for writing lesson plans are organized every year in the college

**Provision of Academic Support:** Along with mentor support, student-teachers are provided help through content enrichment programs. Content Enrichment programs were implemented to enhance comprehension of diverse concepts. These programs are organized based on the requirements of students such as workshops on "Effective Utilization of PowerPoint Presentations in Teaching and Learning", "Creating Online Lesson Plans and Addressing Challenges in Online Practice Teaching", "Training program focused on creating and leveraging Google Classroom".

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Student-teachers were equipped with learning materials and resources, including references to online educational content and links to various educational websites through regularly updated library blogs

#### 4.Left to the judgment of the individual teachers

**Tutorials** - The main goals of a teacher's effective tutorial for pupils should be involvement and clarity. Students took part in interactive talks about networking strategies, interview preparation, and resume writing. The program also featured workshops on creating professional goals and looking into internships. The event's overall goal was to provide students with the skills and information they would need to successfully plan and grow their careers.

**Resume Making Workshop:** A resume-making session was also conducted to assist students in developing their careers. The workshop, which was facilitated by seasoned career counsellors, concentrated on creating strong resumes for teaching and academic careers. Students investigated key components such Contact Information, Professional Summary, Work Experience, and Education in addition to learning about several resume layouts, such as functional and reverse-chronological. The significance of emphasizing teaching abilities, credentials, and pertinent experiences was also addressed throughout the session. Students received tailored feedback and interactive exercises to help them create resumes that make an impression. Enhancing students' employability and preparedness for the workforce was the goal of the event.
