

Guru Purnima (Poornima) is an eastern spiritual tradition dedicated to spiritual and academic teachers, who are evolved or enlightened humans, ready to share their wisdom, with very little or no monetary expectation. It is celebrated as a festival in Nepal by the <u>Nepalese Hindus and Buddhists</u>. This festival is traditionally observed essentially by <u>Jains</u> and <u>Buddhists</u> to revere their chosen spiritual teachers / leaders and express their gratitude. The festival is celebrated on the <u>full moon</u> day (<u>Purnima</u>) in the Hindu month of <u>Ashadha</u> (June–July) as it is known in the <u>Hindu calendar</u> of <u>India</u> and <u>Nepal</u>.

The celebration is marked by spiritual activities and may include a ritualistic event in honor of the <u>Guru</u>, <u>Guru Pooja</u>. The Guru Principle is said to be a thousand times more active on the day of Guru purnima than on any other day. [2] The word Guru is derived from two words, <u>gu</u> and <u>ru</u>. The Sanskrit root <u>gu</u> means darkness or ignorance, and <u>ru</u> denotes the remover of that darkness. Therefore, a Guru is one who removes the darkness of our ignorance. Gurus are believed by many to be the most necessary part of life. On this day, disciples offer <u>pooja</u> (worship) or pay respect to their <u>Guru</u> (spiritual guide). In addition to having religious importance, this festival has great importance for Indian academics and scholars. Indian academics celebrate this day by thanking their teachers as well as remembering past teachers and scholars.

After that Yasmeen asked our principal madam to share her thoughts with us.


She read all the charts which we displayed on the black board and explained us the meaning of them. Then she read out one Sanskrit doha mentioned below:-


Preparation


Constitution Day Celebration
